

WHAT'S A "CAN" CARD? The CAN card is your office or lab's "charge card", used for the purchase of supplies at the Self-Service-Store (SSS). Each card must be authorized in

NBS by your Budget Officers and is associated with a "Common Account Number" that correlates that card to the owner.

SO WHY SHOULD I USE IT? Easy shopping at the Self-Service Stores, less administrative burden, same day receipt of goods, no charge fees; the list goes on and on!

IS A CAN CARD DIFFERENT THAN A P-CARD (PURCHASE CARD)? IF I HAVE A PCARD, CAN I STILL GET A CAN CARD? **YES!** and **YES!** The CAN card is your ticket to shop at the Self-Service Store (SSS) with **0** paperwork, and **0** additional fees. Shop for all your lab and office needs at the SSS and carry your items out the **same day**.

Enterprise Acquisition Nitrile Gloves Industry Day

In **collaboration** with HHS, NIH Division of Logistics Services hosted the HHS BUYSMARTER Industry Day focused on the procurement on Nitrile Gloves on July 21st, 2022. Over 130 industry representatives and HHS and NIH leadership engaged in a robust and transparent discussion to help inform the future nitrile glove acquisition strategy.

The NIH Supply Center was asked to lead the enterprise-wide nitrile gloves acquisition across all of HHS. Our team developed and distributed a survey across the HHS scientific community to gather information regarding nitrile gloves characteristics and requirements and issued findings in the HHS nitrile glove survey report in November 2022.

Special thanks to DOHS, Lab Managers, OHSC, the NIH scientific community, OLAO's Office of Acquisitions and OLAO Category Management team for informing our survey and for making Industry Day a great success!

Congratulations to the Optimize Property Team for their recent graduation from the program. The Optimize Property Team recently presented at an Executive Office Monthly meeting, to discuss all the accomplishments of the optimize program and benefits gained from this initiative. Our team is moving on to Grad School for some of our initiatives including Inventory Modernization, Document Automation, and Central Receiving.

Electronic Content Management (ECM) Loans:

Now that the Report of Survey Tool (ROST) is up and running NIH-wide, the ECM team has begun collecting criteria from the Loans Workgroup. This information will be used to develop a similar enterprise-wide tool for automating both the Domestic and Foreign Loans and Foreign Donations.

Network Discovery and RFID

OLAO is currently in the process of modernizing the annual inventory process with the goal improving efficiency and accountability! The Property Management Branch (PMB) is leading the charge by exploring the use of Endpoint Management Software such as BigFix and Radio Frequency Identification (RFID) technology through a pilot program with select ICs. PMB's goal is to combine these technologies in an advanced and comprehensive solution that minimizes disruption to the NIH community while improving accountability of NIH personal property. Results from the pilot phase thus far have been promising and PMB looks forward to completing testing, rolling out the changes, and improving how NIH manages its personal property!

TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT BRANCH (TMB)


The NIH is on track to reach 100% zeroemission light-duty vehicle acquisitions by FY2027 in accordance with Executive Order 14057: Catalyzing Clean Energy Industries and Jobs Through Federal Sustainability. Read more about E.O. 14057 here.

In FY2022, the NIH Transportation Management Branch purchased 8 new electric hybrid vehicles (100% electric hybrid acquisition).
